What to Expect

Singing ~ Ephesians 5:19; Colossians 3:16; Hebrews 13:15

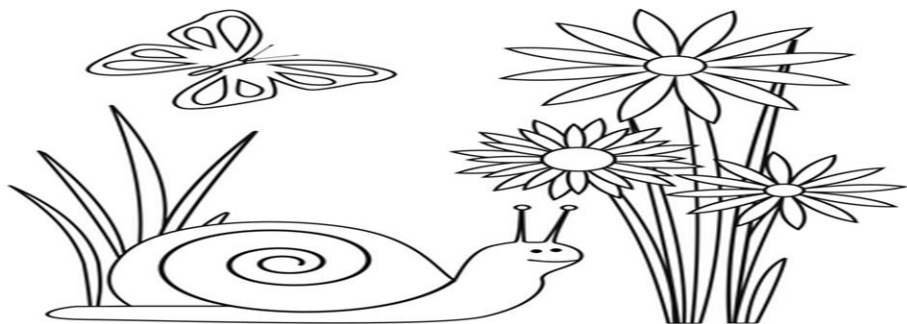
